Crabby Care Corner:

Beginner tip: As the seasons change so does the temperature. Opening windows on a cool day can cause condensation, if it is not a long term issue a quick wipe will solve the problem, but continuous condensation can cause a flood. Hot air holds a larger volume of water so when you change your house from your winter temperature of choice to your summer one you may see some humidity swings. You can use a wet moss pit to add humidity or a dry one to help soak some up.



Advanced tip: When you see a crab swimming most of the time it is in larger pools. Keepers have noticed a few things that encourage crabs to swim. Filtered pools seem to be one source of appeal and adding some live rock to your salt pool is a great idea. It adds more microorganisms and is easy for crabs to climb. Don't fret about the algae growing in your pools, crabs have even been known to snack on some types.

What kind of helmet does a hermit crab wear? A shell-met!


